**SHS MARCHING BAND TO HOST
“MUSIC OF THE KNIGHT”**

On Saturday, October 22, at Southington High School's Fontana Field, the Southington High School Blue Knights Marching band presents the 13th Annual **Music of the Knight**. This event is a United States Scholastic Band Association (USSBA) sanctioned competition featuring a total of 17 bands from Connecticut and Massachusetts.

The evening kicks off at 4:30 PM with the Presentation of Colors by the First Company Governor's Foot Guard, then the National Anthem – this year performed by the Joseph A. DePaolo Middle School band under the Direction of Manny Lopes. The John F. Kennedy Middle School Band under the Direction of Tim Johnson will also perform. Bands from five different classes will then compete for awards including placement trophies in each class, caption trophies (Best Color Guard, Best Marching, Best Percussion, Best Music, Best Overall Effect), and “Grand Champion.”

The Award Winning Southington Blue Knights Marching Band under the Direction of Jeff Shaw, will also perform an exhibition of their 2005 Repertoire, “Da Vinci's Dream, A History of Flight.” In keeping with tradition, SHS Band Alumni will lead the Blue Knights onto the field for their performance. In addition, Boston University's 100-member Terrier Marching Band will be on hand to perform their 2005 show, "Boston Does Boston", featuring the music of the rock band *Boston*.

Alan Camp, Program Director and host of the Morning Show at WRCH Lite 100.5, will be the announcer for the evening's festivities. Special guests and dignitaries will also be on hand to present the awards at the end of the competition.

Music of the Knight has been designated a "Gold Event" by the USSBA and is one of the largest and well-attended High School Band Competitions in New England. To accommodate the anticipated turnout, over 100 volunteers from the Southington Band Backers organization will be on hand to provide food and band merchandise, as well as coordinate the competition.

Tickets are available at the door the day of the event: General Admission, \$7.00; Seniors & Students, \$5.00; Children under 5, as well as Southington Marching Band Alumni wearing their band jacket, will be admitted for FREE. Parking will be available at the high school, with additional parking and shuttle service available from DePaolo Middle School and The Calendar House (located on Pleasant St.)
